

Lent 2024 Reading Plan

"Lent is the season that...calls us back to God, back to basics, back to the spiritual realities of life. It calls us to put to death the sin and the indifference we have in our hearts toward God and our fellow persons. During Lent, we take time to identify with Jesus' journey toward the cross and its significance for our own lives. It is a call to recognize sin, deny it, repent of it, and experience the healing, joy, and life found in our salvation won by Jesus' death for us. Use this card as a prompt prayer and reflection during this season of Lent.

Each day of Lent (except Sundays), set aside time to do the following:

- 1** - Begin with 2 to 5 minutes of uninterrupted silence with Jesus
- 2** - Read the daily Scripture reading
- 3** - Pause and reflect on the reading
(see prompts on back)
- 4** - Repeat steps 2 & 3 at least one time
- 5** - Pray the prayer of confession
- 6** - Conclude with a worship song

Prayer of Confession:

Gracious Heavenly Father, I look to your Son, Jesus, today and ask to be reminded of the many ways in which you have shown me grace and mercy through his sacrifice. I know that I am called to follow the way of Jesus, to carry my own cross, to go wherever you lead, and to extend your grace and mercy to those around me. However, I often fail to follow you. I fall short. I ask that today you would create in me a new and contrite heart, that you renew my resolve to follow your way as I confess my sins to you now. Take a few minutes to be honest with God and yourself and confess your sins to him.
